





### Corn-Sausage Chowder yields 6 servings

#### Ingredients:

- 1 lb. bulk pork sausage
- 1 c. coarsely chopped onion
- 4 c. peeled potatoes cut in  $\frac{1}{2}$ " cubes
- 2 c. water
- 1 t. salt
- $\frac{1}{2}$  t. dried marjoram, crushed
- $\frac{1}{8}$  t. freshly ground pepper
- 1 17oz. can cream style corn
- 1 17oz. can whole kernel corn, drained
- 1 12 oz. can evaporated milk

#### Directions:

In a dutch oven or kettle, cook the sausage & onion until the sausage is brown & the onion is tender. Drain on paper towels.

#### Step 2

Return mixture to Dutch oven. Stir in potatoes, water, and seasonings. Bring to boiling, reduce heat. Simmer uncovered, about 15 minutes or until potato is just tender.

#### Step 3

Add the 2 cans of corn & the evaporated milk. Heat through. Serve hot with crackers or corn bread.

## KNEPFLA SOUP

### *Knepfla Dough:*

3 or 4 c. flour  
3 eggs

salt  
water

Combine flour, eggs, salt and enough water to make a stiff dough. Work dough with hands until it is mixed well and firm. (Can't be sticky) Let set for 30 minutes.

### *Broth for Soup*

2 c. water  
4 or 5 chicken bouillon cubes  
4 lg. potatoes, into sm. pcs.  
2 med. onions, chopped

2 stalks celery, chopped  
2 cans chicken broth  
salt & pepper  
2 c. half & half cream


Peel potatoes and cut into small pieces. Add chopped celery, potatoes and onions to 2 c. water and chicken bouillon according to your taste. Add chicken broth, salt and pepper. Cook slowly until tender. Add half & half.

Bring to a boil a large kettle of salted water. Snip pieces of Knepfla dough into boiling water, (I snip mine on a cookie sheet). Put into boiling water. Stir well. Boil until done, then drain and add to the broth mix. Simmer for awhile, stir well and serve. Left overs are microwavable. Makes 6 or more servings.
