Some need you more then others so we must pay attention and listen. A few you have to work a little harder to get close to!!

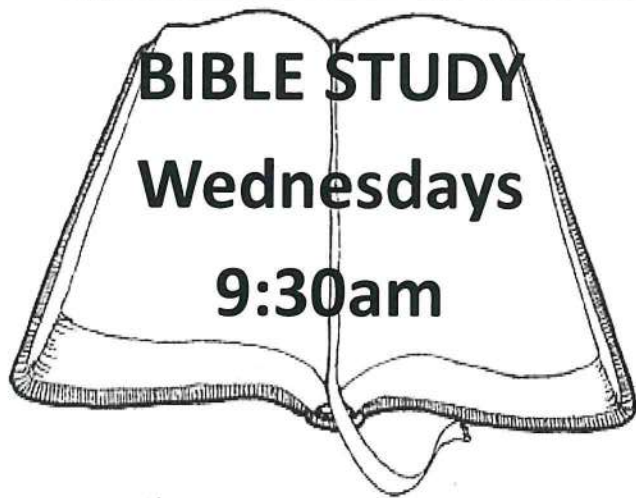
